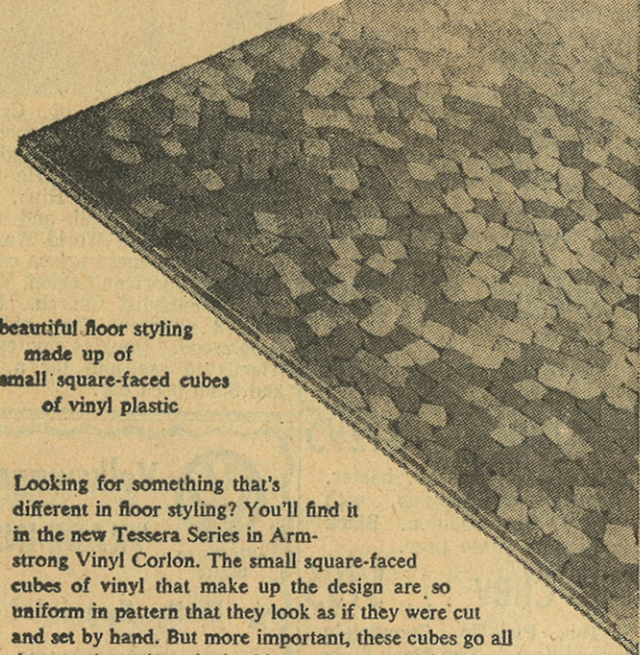

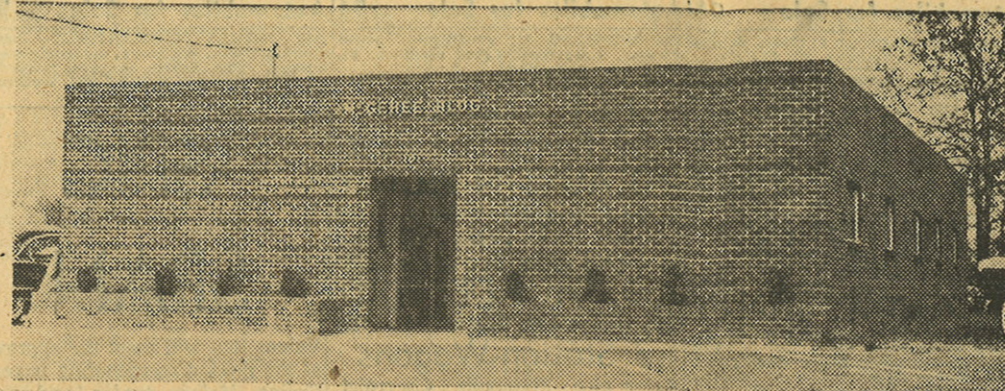

Automatic Switch

Automatic closet switches are now available which turn on the closet light when you open the door, turn it off when the door is shut, the American Home Lighting Institute reported.

Remove Fuse First

If you replace an old fixture with a new one, be sure you remove the circuit fuse first. The American Home Lighting Institute recommends this as a safeguard against shock. The fuse is re-inserted when the job is done.
