[Vinny Petrarca](#), [Sara Queen](#), [Jay Smith](#), and [David Hill](#) took about 60 NCSU architecture students to [Frank Lloyd Wright's Fallingwater](#) August 24-25. Built between 1936 and 1939, the house captured the nation's imagination when it was featured on the cover of *Time* magazine in 1938. The students also studied land next to Fallingwater that is the site for their semester-long studio project. TMH donated breakfast from Bojangles for everyone on Saturday morning.



The 1951 David and Gladys Wright House in Phoenix AZ was designed by [Frank Lloyd Wright](#) for his son. Earlier this year, the buyer, developers 8081 Meridian Corporation, promised the house would be preserved. **Now they have backed off that promise.** In July 2012, the [Frank Lloyd Wright Building Conservancy](#) was awarded a temporary demolition delay while the City of Phoenix decides whether to bestow historic preservation and landmark

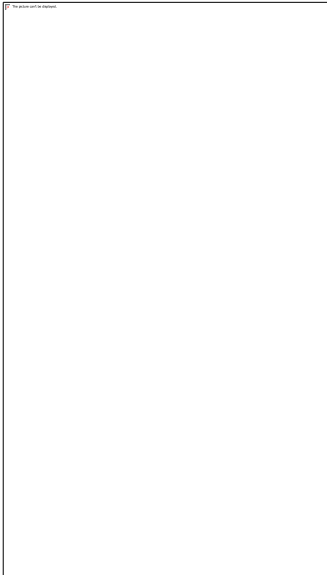
