






January 8 Movie: If You Build It

National Endangerment Alert: Edward Durell Stone's Johnson House

The 1954 Walter and Edith Johnson House in Darien CT, aka the Dogtrot House, was designed by <u>Edward Durell Stone</u> and has been lovingly maintained over the decades by just two owners. This was Stone's final work to outwardly emulate Wrightian detailing, a practice that began with Stone's visit to <u>Taliesin</u> in 1940. The owner needs our help. At the time, the house was vacant and not in the greatest shape, but this past year the family renovated the interior and installed new water, gas, and GFI service and a total re-stain for the beautiful exterior.
