Endangered: A developer is about to buy the immaculate **Jack Boyte**designed Solomon Levine House, 2300 Cloister Drive, in the Cloisters neighborhood of Charlotte NC.

Under contract but not yet closed, the 1956 house is one of Charlotte's finest examples of mid-century modern. Up to now, owners Carol Ambrose and Andrew Beary were ardent preservationists, opening up the house for tours and attempting to get City historic landmark status from the Charlotte City Council in 2008 with enthusiastic support from the Historic Landmarks Commission and North Carolina State Preservation Office. All along, the owners considered themselves stewards of the beautiful property, with unique features such as a kosher kitchen, and promised neighbors not to sell to developers.

On March 14, the Trump administration issued an executive order targeting the nation's only federal agency for America's libraries, the Institute for Museum and Library Services (IMLS), for elimination.

Rumored Destroyed: Help us verify the status of the Apex Department Store., 100 Main Street, Pawtucket RI, which was scheduled to be destroyed this past weekend. Designed by **Andrew Geller** in 1960, it has been called the "**soul of Pawtucket**." Others, like Modernist critic **David Brussat**, have long called for its demolition. It's now owned by the City of Pawtucket.




The 1963 Foley House designed by **John Hans Ostwald** in Berkeley CA sold for 101% of asking price in a **furious bidding war.**



Endangered: No good news for **Frank Lloyd Wright's** Walser House in Chicago. The deteriorating 1930s house made **Preservation Chicago's list of the seven most-endangered historic buildings** and is in foreclosure.

Endangered: The Alice Ball House in New Canaan CT, designed by **Philip Johnson**, is **up for auction April 22 due to around \$163000 in unpaid property taxes**. Not in the greatest shape, it could be a teardown unless a new, caring owner steps up. There is no minimum bid. **CTtaxsales.com** explains the process. Bidding begins at 11am at the New Canaan Town Hall, 77 Main Street, New Canaan CT.



The Village of Southampton Architectural Review Board (ARB), continues to relentlessly pursue forced landmarking of five Modernist houses, three by **Norman Jaffe** (like the Bliss house at left), and one each by **Myron Goldfinger** and **Ward Bennett.**

At the last **epic six-hour meeting**,

preservation experts representing the town and owners gave reports about whether the houses qualified for landmarking, then the owner attorneys tore into the ARB's aggressive lack of transparency, violation of town and national policies, disregard for homeowner rights, and absence of a public ARB vote to pursue this landmarking effort to begin with.

We're all in favor of Modernist preservation, but this is absolutely not the right way to go about it. Yet again, a meeting to make a final decision has been kicked many months down the road, this time to **Monday, September 22, 6pm ET**. Watch it over Zoom.





Lawrence Kocher and Albert Frey and now moving to its new, permanent home at the Palm Springs Art Museum.

The Aluminaire House was conceived

and constructed as an exhibition house for the Allied Arts and Industry and Architectural League Exhibition of 1931 at the Grand Central Palace in New York City. The Aluminaire House is considered a masterpiece of modernist design, listed by Architectural Record as one of the most important buildings completed worldwide in the past 125 years. **Order**.



Available now: *The Round Houses of 1959: James Strutt*, written by **Peter Geldart**. Strutt (1924-2008) was an architect in the Ottawa, Canada region. He graduated in architecture from the University of Toronto in 1950 and taught at the School of Architecture at Carleton University from 1969, serving as Director 1987-1988. Influences included American architects **Frank Lloyd Wright** and **Buckminster Fuller**. For these round houses he abandoned bungalow and based his concept on a curve of rooms and an open living-dining area, surrounding a central core of services to reduce building

costs yet have an ergonomic, inviting space. Order.

Available May 6: *Modern Floral: Timeless Interiors Inspired by Nature*, by **Charlotte Coote**. 
