



### **ENERGY:**

itle III of the National Energy Conservation Policy Act (NECPA) establishes a cost-sharing program for public and non-profit schools and hospitals. The purpose of this program is to assist owners/operators of buildings in all of these categories to identify and implement energy conservation operations and maintenance (O&M) measures; to evaluate the potential for energy conservation measures; and, for schools and hospitals to acquire and install energy conserving capital improvements. According to Federal regulations, the major goal of the grant program is to reduce the consumption and associated costs of conventional energy resources used by eligible public and nonprofit institutions. Cost-sharing funds appropriated by Congress for implementing the program are administered in Indiana by the Indiana Energy Section. Program funds are available on a fifty percent matchina basis.

There are three types of projects funded under NECPA. The first, Energy Audit (EA) is a brief on-site survey and analysis of a facility. This step must be completed by a certified Energy Auditor. A certified Energy Auditor is an individual who has completed one of the training sessions held by the Indiana Energy Section.

The second type of project funded is a Technical

Assistance Project (TAP). The TAP report is meant to serve as a basis for analyzing possible energy conservation measures. This report must be done by an engineer or architect registered in the State of Indiana. Both the Energy Audit and the Technical Assistance Project are prerequisites in applying for the third type of funding, the Energy Conservation Measure.


The NECPA funding for an Energy Conservation Measure (ECM) project is intended to assist in the purchase and installation of energy saving equipment recommended in the Technical Assistance Project.

Regardless of the type of project for which assistance is requested, it is important that the institution meet requirements set forth by the federal government and the State of Indiana.

We encourage the readers of the Indiana Architect to participate in the Schools and Hospital program by informing the public and non-profit institutions in their areas of the program and the subsequent services of the architect and engineer.

### John H. Jelliffe, AIA Treasurer





## Meadowood offers choice lifestyle

he gently rolling hills of scenic Southern Indiana soon will welcome a new lifestyle community designed for persons who share a unique and intense love: Indiana University.

Meadowood, a development of apartment units and cluster homes immediately north of I.U.'s Bloomington campus, has been planned especially for university alumni, faculty and staff age 60 or older. James Associates Architects & Engineers, Inc., Indianapolis, is the firm in charge of design for Meadowood. Thomas G. Allen, AIA, is project architect with Thomas C. Dorste, AIA, principal-in-charge.

The community is a dream-come-true for I.U. Chancellor Herman B. Wells who first proposed such a facility for the Bloomington campus several years ago. "Meadowood," he relates, "is the realization of our dream of a community where friends of this great university can enjoy and enhance its facilities and environment."

It is a prototype community, the first of its kind in the nation affiliated with an institution of higher education. Although funded privately through a tax exempt bond issue, Meadowood enjoys the enthusiastic endorsement of university administration, the Alumni Association and the I.U. Foundation. It is, in fact, to be constructed on 3O acres of land donated by the Foundation. The tract is located just north of Assembly Hall off of State Road 46 by-pass.

Thomas Allen contends that "we've tried to think of everything in planning Meadowood," and indeed it would be difficult to discover an amenity that has been overlooked. Ninety-two garden cluster units will grace the beautifully landscaped 3O acres while 92 apartments in a series of five connecting buildings will be centrally located on the site. The exteriors of all Meadowood units will be composed primarily of rustic wood and stone from Monroe and Brown Counties.

The apartment buildings connect with a community center featuring a wide variety of social and recreational facilities including pool, exercise room, ping pong and billiards area, private and common dining rooms, barber shop and beauty salon. A library (already with many volumes committed) also will be housed in the center along with a greenhouse, lounge with wet bar and fireplace, gift and sundry shop, card and game room and arts and crafts workshop.

A staff utilizing complete kitchen facilities in the community center will prepare and serve meals daily to residents who desire the companionship of their Meadowood neighbors during mealtime. Special dietary requirements will be met upon request.

Outdoor recreational facilities include shuffleboard and tennis courts plus a footpath which winds throughout the grounds.

A comprehensive Medicare-approved health care center also is planned at Meadowood. It will include a 25-bed facility for temporary or extended nursing care with both private and semi-private accommodations. A clinic for preventive medical examinations by the residents' own physicians is included along with physical, occupational, speech and hearing therapy areas. Emergency nursing assistance in each resident's living unit will be available if needed, while 14 "assisted living units" will be offered to residents needing assistance with prescribed medication, bathing, dressing and walking.

Spectacular as these features are, the highlight of Meadowood is in the actual living areas. A full range of options is offered, from actual architectural changes within the individual units to the addition of private carports and garages.

#### Meadowood offers choice lifestyle



The spectacular community and health care center building is the centerpiece of Meadowood. The community, located just north of Indiana University's Bloomington campus, is convenient to shopping areas and will provide mini-bus service throughout Bloomington to its residents.



Ninety-two apartment units in five connecting buildings are only part of the offering at Meadowood, a Bloomington community for persons 60 years of age or older and affiliated with Indiana University.

Twelve different cluster unit and apartment floor plans are featured. The apartments range from a 360 square foot studio (the only Meadowood unit without a terrace or balcony) to a 1,253 square foot three-bedroom unit. The cluster homes begin with a standard one-bedroom facility offering 573 square feet of living space and increase in size to a three-bedroom home with 1,263 square feet of area. Again, many options – even Franklin stoves – can be added at residents' requests.

Meadowood landscaping has been important to development plans, according to architect Allen. "We've planned, along with Fritz Loonsten, the consulting landscape architect, to construct around the numerous large trees on the site," he said, "and have set aside garden and wildflower areas." The aforementioned footpath winds throughout the community, around a pond and along a stream. Elevation of the 3O-acre tract varies greatly from one area to the next and the James Associates planner has taken into account the possible dangers posed by this variance and has contrasted colors along the footpath to indicate changes in terrain.

Bids on the project were taken in February and

earthwork at the site has begun. Early occupancy is anticipated by mid-October.

When completed, Meadowood will be owned by its residents and governed by an elected board of directors. For legal purposes, Indiana University Retirement Community, Inc., a not-for-profit organization, was formed to oversee development. Original development consultation and day-to-day management is provided by MacIntosh Associates.

Residency fees based upon the type of unit selected are charged. Once this fee is paid, however, lifetime use of the apartment or cluster is guaranteed to the resident. Approximately 200 residents, 48 of whom are charter members including Chancellor Wells, already have committed to the Meadowood community. In addition to the one-time fee, a monthly service charge for administrative and general operating expenses is assessed, again based upon type of unit purchased and services utilized.

Meadowood is, by design, a unique community in that Indiana University has played a major role in the lives of all its residents. And, as Chancellor Wells and other supporters believe, "it affords a new and exciting opportunity for members of the I.U. family."

Proud of Her Glorious Past.
Peering with Confidence into her Brilliant Future.
To-day a thoroughly American Metropolis.

In presenting this volume to the public some few introductory remarks are necessary. Nowhere on the continent is there a similar city to Indianapolis; her central location, railway facilities, and remarkable resources have made her one of the most important and progressive manufacturing and commercial centres of America. What the future or limits of the city may yet be, no one can faintly imagine. Her wealth and trade increase materially day by day; new enterprises and capital are daily drawn to her centre, which, combined with the energy, industry and perseverance of her citizens, must more firmly than ever establish and increase the widespread fame and reputation of this important railway centre. All will admit that it requires no optimistic pen to record the proaressiveness of Indianapolis as few cities in the world possess the many manifold advantages, which Nature, with imperial prodigality, has so richly endowed her. This volume is intended to disabuse forever the mind of the American public that our claims to prolific progress are mere day-dreams, but, by a plain and simple arraignment of facts, to substantiate the claim that Indianapolis is of surety in the van of progression among American cities.

We will attempt no mere word-painting, but approach the task without fear or favor, feeling satisfied, when a perusal of our efforts is concluded, the most critical will admit that we have not erred on the side of egotism in styling Indianapolis one of the foremost cities of America – mirabile dictu, mirabile visu (wonderful to tell of, wonderful to see), a veritable Triton among the minnows of the mercantile and manufacturing communities of America.

So wrote the editor of a 10½" x 7½" paperback entitled "Indianapolis of Today" compiled and published by Consolidated Illustrating Co. Were it not for mention of extensive railway facilities the less informed might assume the introductory paragraphs were written today. The fact is, this 227 page profile of Indianapolis was released during the administration of Thomas Taggart, Mayor of Indianapolis some 85 years ago in 1896. The Honorable Claude Matthews was then Governor of Indiana.

Although the publication does not list all commercial enterprises in the city at that period, it does highlight some 46O businesses and a few professionals operating at the time. (My guess is that the book was funded by those organizations illustrated). In any event it gives a good overview of a seemingly thriving community a few years before the turn of the century and looks to the future with optimism and dedication.

It would be interesting to speculate on the publisher's comments, if he were here today, especially in connection with the severe decline in the railway system. On the other hand, with plans for restoration of the Indianapolis Union Station as a central transportation facility, most might generally agree that there is indeed hope for creating a future for the past of this significant structure. Although some other structures of the preturn of the century period still remain, even more have been lost that no doubt would have been saved, had the interest in preservation 20 or 30 years ago attained the same popularity it enjoys today.

One cannot help but reflect on the many truly fine structures illustrated in the 1896 brochure that no longer remain. Many of our elder Hoosiers will recall with pleasure the finer architectural compositions that served our community before the turn of the century and have since been replaced with, in many cases, little more than filing cabinet architecture. As we

glance through the 1896 publication, our attention is drawn to photographs of fine structures which once occupied sites in the mile square. The United States Post Office and Federal Building, designed by U.S. Treasury Architect, A.T. Young in 1856, stood on the southeast corner of Pennsylvania and Market Streets, now occupied by Union Federal Savings & Loan. The Grand Dennison House/Hotel which occupied the southeast corner of Ohio and Pennsylvania Streets, and was replaced by a multi-level parking facility. The site of the Old Indianapolis Public Library at the southwest corner of Ohio and Meridian Streets later became the headquarters for the Indianapolis Public Schools and has since been replaced with the Hilton Hotel. All that remains of the old library is the statue which once graced the roof at the center of the building and during demolition was salvaged and temporarily moved to Crown Hill Cemetery. It now rests on a permanent foundation on the west side of the present Indianapolis Central Library. The southeast corner or intersection of Virginia Avenue and Pennsylvania Street was long identified as the headquarters for Indiana National Bank, Since its demolition, it is now the home of Jefferson National Life Insurance Company.

Monument Circle has seen a great many changes from the site of the original governor's mansion where

the monument now stands. Surrounded by structures of a more domestic scale, including the original Columbia Club, appearing as a two story town house. The English Opera House and Hotel, raised in the late 1940s and replaced with the J.C. Penney Building awaits yet another transformation and new use, with plans proposed by Blue Cross.

An interesting sidelight to the demise of the English Theatre is a statement by internationally prominent architect, Nathaniel Owings (SOM) in his book The Spaces in Between - "Sadly, in the process of working on another job on the circle with my sensitivity to the past still undeveloped, I helped destroy the 1850 Victorian English Hotel and Theatre. The structure which replaced this gem was a simple limestone facade, fitted to the circle's curve with scalloped portico projecting which cast an interesting shadow on the long plain curve. On the Sunday following dedication, the minister of the little Norman church next door (Christ Church), bewailed this act of vandalism, labeled it a stone curtain and suggested that Russia's Iron Curtain was but a step behind. The doorman of the club across the street (Columbia Club), took issue on this subject and was supported by taxi drivers lined up outside waiting for a fare. Facing the same problem today, I would support the minister in his passion."

We have also witnessed in our time, the destruction of the Old Claypool Hotel and its neighbor, the Lincoln which in a matter of seconds was reduced to a pile of rubble and dust through modern demolition methods. Preservationists have shed tears over the loss of many fine buildings, later to often view gaping voids or erect mediocre new construction on the same site. In recent years however, as the general public and business community have become more aware and sensitive to their architectural heritage, exciting and imaginative solutions have provided new life for old structures.

Members of the architectural profession have taken an active part in the promotion of vintage buildings for new uses, and in several cases have acquired early structures to house their own offices and for investment purposes. The House of Crane Building at 124 South Meridian Street, owned by Browning, Day, Pollak & Associates, and the Majestic Building recently purchased by Evans Woollen are examples. The Hammond Block Building at the intersection of Massachusetts Avenue and New York Street, was saved by Schmidt/Claffey Associates, who interested a client in restoring the building that they currently occupy as a tenant. An upper level of the Old Morrison Opera Place on South Meridian Street, owned by Tom Huston, was rehabilitated by Archonics, and serves as their office. The inventory of restored structures in Marion County alone is quite extensive, including house museums, such as the Morris Butler House, Kemper House and the President Benjamin Harrison Memorial Home, all open to the public. Larger restorations, such as the Indianapolis City Market and the Indiana Theatre add to the stability of the central city.

Only two architectural firms are listed in the 1896 publication, although this did not represent the entire profession at the time. The firm of Robert Frost Daggett & Company and W. Scott Moore & Son, Architects were described with examples of their work listed. The names of many buildings we recognize are still standing, while others have fallen to the wrecking ball.

R.P. Daggett & Company in 1896, maintained offices at 28 and 32 Marion Building and were ranked among the leading architects in the state. R.P. Daggett was the founder and head of the firm, dating back to 1868. In 1880 Mr. Daggett formed a partnership with James B. Lizius and buildings designed by the Daggett firm included the Lemcke Building, Sayles Building, Loraine Building, Marion Building, Wrights' Market Street Block, Exchange Block, Dean Brothers Steam Pump Works, Eli

Lilly & Company's Laboratory, Wm. B. Burford's Printing House, The Indiana Medical College, The Indianapolis News Company and the Lombard Building at 22 East Washington Street. The Lombard is among those that remain and is currently in the planning stage for adaptive reuse by its owner, Richard Butz.

W. Scott Moore & Son, Architects maintained offices at the corner of Washington and Meridian Streets. This business was first inaugurated in 1885 by Mr. Moore, and in January of 1896, his son, Edwin F. Moore, was admitted to partnership. Some of their works included The Temple House of Scottish House Masons, Central Christian Church, Tabernacle Church, The New York Store, The Macy Building, Meridian Building and private residences such as The Honorable Thomas Taggart Home, V.M. Backus, James E. Lilly and Charles Meyers; all names which we recognize as early contributors to the development growth of Indianapolis.

This writer proposes to relate in future issues of the Indiana Architect, some interesting documentation concerning the early architectural offices in the city and state. The work of our predecessors should not be forgotten as they indeed laid the foundation for those of us in practice today. More and more as we investigate the fabric of many early structures, we learn to appreciate not only the architect, but the master craftsman; the man on the job who possessed a certain obvious pride of worksmanship resulting in an achievement of quality.

H. Roll McLaughlin, FAIA, has been a principal with James Associates Architects and Engineers since 1956, and is now a partner of the firm's Special Services Division. The author of numerous articles, McLaughlin is a four-time winner of Indiana Society of Architects Biennial Awards and has received many citations from federal and state officials and institutions for his preservation work. He is a past president and currently chairman emeritus of the Historic Landmarks Foundation of Indiana, and a member of the board for Preservation Action in Washington, DC. He is an advisory board member for Historic Madison, Inc.; served for six years on the Historic American Building Survey Advisory Board, Division of the National Park Service; and is currently a trustee for the Indianapolis Museum of Art. He serves as a member of the American Institute of Architects Historic Resources Committee, the Indiana Professional Review Committee for National Register Nominations and State Register, is the State Preservation Coordinator for the Indiana Society of Architects and is a member of the state committee for the Preservation of Architectural Records. McLaughlin was elected to the American Institute of Architects College of Fellows in 1970, and the Indiana Academy in 1973. Registered in seven states and holding a certificate with the National Council of Architectural Registration Boards, McLaughlin attended John Herron Art School and has studied architecture in Central America, North and East Africa, the British Isles and central Europe.



## The Code Board

Recently, the federal government, under Vice President George Bush, chairman of the Presidential Task Force on Regulatory Relief, has taken further steps to curb existing and pending federal regulations, many of which affect the building design profession. This action is welcomed by the majority of architects and design firms within our state.

The hundreds of federal departments cannot be compared with the tens of state agencies having an effect upon the construction industry within Indiana – the Indiana Air Pollution Board, State Boiler-Pressure Vessel Board, IOSHA, Health Facilities Board, Environmental Management Board, Handicapped Study Mission, Stream Pollution Control Board, Plumbing Commission, Natural Resources Board, Labor Department, Division of Insurance, Highway Commission, Elevator Board, Engineers and Surveyors Board, Department of Public Instruction, Administrative Building Council, State Board of Health, the State Fire Marshall's Office, the State Building Commission, and the Historical Preservation Division. There is no question that building regulations are a necessary part of the building industry, but architects have watched as various state agencies become ever more involved in the construction process, often at jurisdictional cross-purposes.

Also, no comparison can be made between the federal government's propensity to proliferate provoking bureaucratic discretionary fiats and our state agencies' lawful rules and regulations. But the design profession has observed such agency increases. For example: in 1969, the State Building Commission was reorganized and increased from one man (and two

office helpers) into an agency which today has approximately 30 office personnel supporting nearly 24 inspectors in the field. Also, architects have watched as construction codes have been increased in this department alone from a few basic building codes into eight different printed codes – the Dwelling Code, the Building Code, the Mechanical Code, the Plumbers Code, the Swimming Pool Code, the Electrical Code, Lighting Regulations and the Energy Code. And nearly every year the state revises these codes for various administrative and authoritative reasons.

This may be the time for the state to follow the lead of the Presidential Task Force on Regulatory Relief, and ask the governor to create a similar group – a commission headed by the lieutenant governor, charged with revision of the cost/benefits and value/effectiveness of the state's existing and proposed construction regulations. Such action would be an administrative matter, requiring no new legislation for its implementation. The task force could search for alternatives to the steady growth of state agency regulations.

Currently serving as chief architect, City of Indianapolis, Courtney E. Robinson, AIA, is active with the International Conference of Building Officials. He is a representative to the Southern Building Code Congress International, delegate to the Building Officials and Code Administrators International, and regional representative to the national AIA Government and Codes and Standards committees. He is chairman of the sub-committees on structural and architectural standards, as well as a member of the USA Technical Advisory Committee on drawing practices of the American Society of Mechanical Engineers. For ten years, he served Indiana as state code director, state architect and public works director. Robinson was a partner for ten years in Robinson and Fair, AIA, Fort Wayne.

#### Tri-County Opportunity School Noblesville, Indiana

Dedicated on February 22, 1981, Tri-County Opportunity School was designed to serve the educational needs of severely and moderately mentally handicapped students across seven member school corporations: Carmel Clay, Hamilton Heights, Hamilton Southeastern, Marion-Adams, Noblesville, West Cen-

tral Community and Westfield Washington. The facility was designed for a 16O-student capacity and includes classroom, home living, clinic, adaptive physical education, speech, physical and occupational therapy, therapy pool and cafeteria areas. An enclosed walk connects the school with adjacent Hinkle Creek Elementary School to encourage interchange between students and faculties of both schools. Construction costs for the project exceeded 2 million dollars.




#### **Indiana Designed**

The design of this library addition consists of a twostory 100,000 square foot underground structure located directly in front of the main facade of the existing library. While light wells on the southside of the structure allow natural light to penetrate into study areas, the earth envelope's constant temperature is expected to increase energy efficiency. Special services provided within the facility include an independent study center with special roomettes, a library instruction room and a 24-hour study area with vending. The undergraduate library was planned to service approximately 1,000 students.
