EW TERMINAL BUILDING IS PART OF AIRPORT REDEVELOPEMENT

The new commercial terminal building at the Columbia Metrolitan Airport is a part of an overall redevelopment of the existairport. New runways, taxiways, airplane ramps and access ads are already constructed and in use. Private aviation facies are under construction.

A Weather Bureau building and fire station/maintenance comx are in planning. Construction should begin soon on a new atrol tower designed for and built by the Federal Aviation ency. All of this is aimed at providing central South Carolina h a complete and diversified facility to handle "Jet Age" dends.


The new terminal is located at approximately the center point the new runway. It is sited on a slope which rises to the th from the airplane parking ramp; thus a passenger drives to the north side of the building, walks through the lding and descends one level on the south side to reach the

airplane parking level. This change in level has advantages: service areas are located on the lower level and vehicles circulate at the airplane ramp level, one level below passenger and public areas; views from the upper level are enhanced by being raised above the level of the field.

The core of the terminal building is a two-story-high "mall" running north to south shown in the illustrations. The concept is borrowed from the many new shopping center malls. The center of the mall is occupied by seating for passengers awaiting flights. The seating is set amidst large planting areas and a fountain and is surrounded by the main walkway circulation. Surrounding the two-story mall are the various public-serving activities of an airport terminal: the restaurant, coffee shop and tavern at the south end overlooking a spectator garden and the airplane ramp; rest rooms, baggage pick-up counter, auto-rental counters and a small concession area on the east side; a large

eneral merchandise shop, insurance counter, coin-operated ending machine group, bank and stairs to the lower floor occupy he west side; the north end opens to the long car loading loggia ccuping the entire front of the building. The idea is to make aiting or walking through the terminal as pleasant and interesting as possible.

The "L" wing to the west is fronted by the ticketing lobby; rline offices of Delta, Eastern, Southern and Piedmont occupy e south side behind the ticket counters.

The lower level at the front of the building is occupied by ditional public rest room facilities, airport management offices, echanical areas and large unfinished spaces for future expansor of public and airline office areas. The lower level is bisect-by a vehicle underpass used by service traffic. To the south this are the kitchen areas under the restaurant-coffee shopes on the upper level.

Provisions are made in the planning of the building for a ure baggage pick-up wing to the east along the north facade lancing the airline wing to the west. Where and if required, ace will be added around the upper level of the mall to house ch requirements as rented office space. Access to this space I be from a balcony surrounding the upper level of the mall. The upper second story part of the mall rises through the in roof. The sloping exterior walls of this block are sheathed blue porcelain enamel. The flat roof of the main building is ne in a pattern formed by two colors of stone topping. Roof ges are white porcelain enamel. The exposed concrete frame the building is painted a white both on the interior and exior. Oversize brick are used for exterior and interior walls, h accent materials of fine plywood panellings, vinyl wall covers, sculptural tile, etc. at feature areas. Public areas of the ilding are floored with quarry tile in keeping with the garden aracter of the mall.

The route of the passenger to the boarding concourses takes a through garden areas — a general theme of the building. It concourses are fully enclosed for their entire length for the tection and comfort of passengers. Aircraft at the Columbia minal will be too diversified in type in the foreseeable future allow for specific airplane boarding systems (such as secondly direct bridge access) to be incorporated in the original lding. Requirements for such features in the future will be to by remodeling the concourses.

Fronting the building is a large reflecting pool with fountains. pool is set in a large lawn area planted with trees around ch vehicles sweep up to the front of the building.

John Talbert Associates of Wilmington, North Carolina, are engineers for the airport; they designed all the airfield, the system and exterior utilities. Richard K. Webel of Roslyn, g Island, is the landscape architect. He designed the plantwithin the building as well as all of the exterior planting inling large areas of reforestation.

Mechanical engineers for the work are Durlach, O'Neal and kins and Associates; electrical engineers are Holladay, Coleand Associates. Julian Shand is the structural engineer. S.N. Upshur, A.I.D., designed the interior furnishings.

Harllee-Quattlebaum Construction Co. was the general contor for the building. General contractor on the landscaping struction surrounding the building was John F. Chick. Jack ville Associates were contractors for the interior furnishings. The new terminal and airfield facilities were formally dedid the last of May this year; the terminal building was opened operation two weeks before that date. The cost of the terminal complex was slightly less than $1\frac{1}{2}$ million dollars. This ides the cost of landscape construction and the interior furings, but does not include landscape planting or kitchen oment. The building contains approximately 100,000 square of enclosed floor space.








Clemson Growth Typifies S. C. Campus Expansion



A great portion of this expansion is in housing facilities; however, classroom space and university facilities services are getling additional facilities.







INTERSTATE HIGHWAYS CAN CREATE CITY ENTRIES

Gates as entrances to cities and towns, as such, may well be out of date. However, we cannot discredit their usefulness nor he need for them or a successful substitute. On several roads entering Clemson, there still stand stone pilasters marking the entrance to the small college town.


Agreed that today's vehicular motivation has changed scale elations so that such a gate as Clemson's is insignificant from odays speeding automobile.

Our present interstate highway has eliminated the slow aproach to towns that wandered through the outskirts of a town ntil reaching the density of the town center. We can now connue at 65 mph until we descend via an exit into the city center. hough these highways have allowed the obsolescence of village ype entrances, they have opened new possibilities that must be tilized.

There are many ways that city entrances can be achieved long these speedways. Some of these solutions also can deplerate the moving vehicle, which could be virtue enough.

Rhythm plays the important role in this new scale on the ghway. Repeating objects that are regularly spaced are effective ontrols as well as recognizable patterns that change pace. hythm can be achieved with repeating trees, simple road surce, and at night, change in light intensity.

Practical entrances to our state's cities are readily available by. Interstate highways I-20, I-26, I-85 and those yet to be anned, have cut through woods and open land leaving natural rk vistas on either side of the road. Wide median strips have en left with the existing plant growth allowing light protection night. These have created pleasant roads, and more than one rk-like entrance to a town.



th a little planting the scene bottom right could be eatly changed.

This does not last long, as can be readily observed on the d from Greenville-Spartanburg to Columbia. Four years ago s was a picturesque drive. Now on the Columbia end of the d it has deteriorated by urban sprawl from the state's capital. rehouses, commercial structures, and ill-planned housing projs have cluttered the landscape that once was beautiful. It is too late to take some corrective measures. In Connecticut, Merritt Parkway is a lush and pleasant road. Roadside nting effectively screens the unwanted view. There is less fusion along the road from signs and clutter, and there is asure in traveling the road.







When traveling the roads around our towns and now along our interstate highways we might ask ourselves what right have these few individuals to impose ugliness on all of the state's people.

Measures have been investigated and are underway to beautify the entrance to Columbia from the Interstate 26 to Elmwood Avenue which has the dome of the state hospital as its axis. Some of these proposals have been for landscaping, others as sculptural monuments or fountains and some of the proposals are for a combination of these methods; anything will be worth its effort if planned properly.




























Entrance Scheme for New Haven, Connecticut from Connecticut Turnpike.

VENTURI'S PHILADELPHIA FOUNTAIN EXEMPLIFIES VEHICULAR URBAN SCALE

Robert Venturi, a Philadelphia Architect, is a graduate of inceton and a fellow of the American Academy in Rome; he as been a design critic at Princeton, University of Pennsylvania of Yale. His own home was recently shown in the May issue Progressive Architecture.

"Though he has built little his long standing commitment to on-straightforward" architecture, as well as his continual ocation of mannerist precedent have earned him a number of sciples especially in Philadelphia and in the bay region of San ansisco.

This fountain by Venturi is a design solution to the recent illadelphia fountain competition. It is a prime example of ale relating at one point to the pedestrian at close range, and a second point the automobile-pedestrian long range vista.

WATER ACTIONS

The central jet, 60 feet high, relates to the scale and the axis of Benjamin Franklin Parkway. Its constant stream is shielded from the wind by the inner surface which is concave, and is set off by the dark background of the enclosure. From most parts of the plaza only the reverberation of the great jet within the artificial grotto is evident.

The outer surface which is convex, accommodates a constant sheet of water issuing from a weir near the top and continuously dripping from its lower edge into the pool so

that the boldly lettered legend HERE BEGINS FAIRMOUNT PARK is glimpsed through a screen of droplets. This waterfall, with the polished elongated letters, relates to the scale of the individual on the immediate plaza.

LIGHTING


- The central jet is spotlighted by quartz lamps recessed in the base.
- 1.a In the winter months incandescent lamps with amber lenses flood the angular maze of the core structure with yellow light. The central space is dark.
- The angled base is floodlighted by amber-lensed incandescent lamps. This continuous band contrasts with the looming dark body above and, at close range, illuminates the legend.



In recent years studies hav been made of Columbia, Greenville, Anderson and Florence; thi past year the study was Sumter.


Sumter is a county seat; it is located in the very center of South Carolina. Situated in the middle of a triangle connecting interstate highways. Sumter is closely related to Columbia Charleston and Charlotte.

Sumter county had a 74,941 population in the last censurand a fair percentage of these live in or are directly influence by the Sumter metropolitan area. Sumter county has an are of 665 square miles. It is served by rail, bus and air (throug Columbia's new metropolitan airport). The city boasts about 80 industries and is a shopping, governmental, military and industrial center.

Sumter officials expressed an interest in collaborating wit the School of Architecture in the development of Civic Desig Studies for the guidance of their community and its cente Sumter, interestingly, was the first city in the United States t adopt the City-Manager form of government. It has a pe manent planning staff and a sound municipal government.

Students spent the semester in four periods of work: (1) study of planning theory, (2) group investigations of the tow (3) individual sketch plan studies and (4) development of teat town design. Final projects of the semester were specific builting studies by the students.




Proposed Master Plan of Sumter - Team 3.










A second group's plan of proposed Sumter Center.


TUDENTS STUDY OLD FURMAN CAMPUS


The five teams studied varied proposals for this site.

(2) A Medical college complex with all educational facilities and some housing was explored by Kaufmann's group. (3) Appropriate housing usage comprised of row houses, town houses and apartment towers were developed by the studio of Kenneth Russo. (4) A community junior college was the topic of Reep's studio; it was to be a municipal facility and a pedestrian precinct. (5) Joe Young's group proposed a central urban activities center.








A housing scheme - Kenneth Russo, Instructor in Architecture.

CLEMSON ARCHITECTURAL FOUNDATION ENTERS NINTH YEAR OF SERVICE TO PROFESSION

The Clemson Architectural Foundation has entered its ninth ear of service to the art and science of architecture in South arolina through strong support of the educational program in rchitecture and building at Clemson University. Mr. Ralph Mcherson, Architect, of Greenville, South Carolina, completed his erm as President on June 30 and was succeeded by Mr. T. J. issett, Columbia, South Carolina, on July 1.

Mr. McPherson, in summarizing Foundation activities during the past year, describes in glowing terms several events and rograms in architectural education that could not have been possible without Foundation aid. He also praised Mr. Bissett's rong support of Foundation programs and long service to the pouth Carolina Chapter of the American Institute of Architects.



In outlining the Foundation program for the year, he said that thirteen distinguished lecturers and critics had visited the School of Architecture during the 1964-65 academic year. These speakers, all famous in their several fields of specialty, included such persons as Dean John Burchard of the Massachusetts Institute of Technology and Dr. Mario

alvadori of Columbia, covering a range from the visual arts and ty planning to architectural structures.

All speakers and programs were arranged to enable memers of the South Carolina Chapter of the American Institute
Architects to attend and appropriate invitations were issued.
Insee of the speakers were scheduled to be on hand in conection with the Winter Meeting of the South Carolina Chapter
the American Institute of Architects held at Clemson University
the 29th and 30th of January. These were Professor Victor
gyay of Princeton University; Samuel Kruse, FAIA, Architect,
Miami, Florida; and Niklaus Morgenthaler, Architect, of Berne,
witzerland.

The architectural faculty has expanded nearly three-fold since e School was reorganized ten years ago, and although the culty now retains men of diverse capabilities on permanent nure, certain areas of specialty cannot be covered. The visit-g critic program enables the students to hear and work with mous people with unusual capabilities from around the world. The exhibits appearing in the Rudolph Lee Gallery of the hool of Architecture were commenced as a project of the Clemn Architectural Foundation and continue to be of great impornce to the School and University community. These are arranged to broaden the undergraduate student's awareness of various aspects of architecture and the adjunct arts. The arranging of the exhibits is a useful three-dimensional exercise. The various classes, in rotation, take the responsibility of designing and setting up the some twelve shows which occur annually.

A well-known architectural educator has said that helping in the development of one faculty member will touch innumerable students. Based on this philosophy, the Clemson Architectural Foundation in recent years has been spending a higher percentage of its budget to send various members of the staff to special meetings, conventions and short courses. Each year a young member of the faculty attends the teacher training seminars at Cranbrook Academy, Bloomfield Hills, Michigan. This year the seminar concerned itself with construction and structures. Assistant Professor Anders Kaufmann was sent to this year's symposium. Professor Emery Gunnin and Associate Professor Clifton Marshall represented the School of Architecture at a special course in the design of plastics at Massachusetts Institute of Technology at Cambridge, Massachusetts, in June. Richard Reep attended a special course in Fallout Shelter Analysis and Building Design at the University of Colorado in Boulder. In addition to participation in these more lengthy courses, members of the Architectural faculty attended regional meetings of the Association of Collegiate Schools of Architecture, National meetings of the American Institute of Architects and the Association of Collegiate Schools of Architecture, and the regional meeting of the South Eastern College Art Conference. Professor Edward Pinckney, member of the faculty, attended the national convention of the American Society of Landscape Architects.

Field trips continue to be an important part of the educational program in the School of Architecture. These trips are carefully coordinated with the work in the architectural design studios. Fourth year students involved in a major hospital planning program in the fall term were enabled through Foundation funds to visit hospitals throughout the region. Fifth year students were enabled to make frequent trips to Sumter, South Carolina, with Foundation funds. These were later completely covered by a \$1,000 contribution from the City of Sumter to the Foundation.

Fifth year students had a terminal field trip to Philadelphia and New York during spring recess, and student representatives attended National Students Conference in Washington, D. C., last Thanksgiving and the students' portion of the American Institute of Architects convention in Washington, D. C., in June.

Mr. Bissett has promised that the new administration will continue these important projects and expand Foundation activities in keeping with the expanding responsibilities of the School of Architecture and its growing importance in the state and region.
