




ORLEANS .- FACADE OF CATHEDRAL OF STE. CROIX.

DATES FROM THE DECADENCE OF GOTHIC ARCHITECTURE. DESTROYED BY THE HUGUENOTS IN 1567; IT WAS PRACTICALLY REBUILT BETWEEN 1601 AND 1829; THE GREATER PART IN A REPRODUCTION OF THE LATE GOTHIC. THE FLORID FACADE, DESIGNED BY GABRIEL, ARCHITECT TO LOUIS XIV., ATTAINS A CERTAIN AMOUNT OF DIGNITY.


ORLEANS .- DETAIL OF CHIMNEY IN HOTEL DE VILLE.

THE SCULPTURED PANELS ABOVE THE SHELF REPRESENT SCENES IN THE LIFE OF JOAN OF ARC. THE BUILDING DATES FROM 1530, BUT WAS MUCH RESTORED IN 1850. IT WAS FORMERLY THE ROYAL RESIDENCE OF FRANCIS II. WHO DIED HERE IN 1560 IN THE ARMS OF HIS WIFE, MARY STUART.






VITRE. CHATEAU VITRE.-THE TOWER OF ST. LAURENT-XIV. AND XV. CENT.


