Martha Fleming House, [6942 Vicksboro Road](#), Henderson NC. Started in 1944. On 6 acres. Fleming, a NC native, was an aeronautical engineer who worked with Lockheed-Vega out in Southern California during WWII. During their wartime trips to the beach, Mrs. Fleming admired a house built so far up in the Malibu hills. Her husband remembered this as he set about to design this house for her. The house is built primarily of brick; it required 2 years to design and 2.5 years to build. It features a bomb shelter and a hidden room, with a motorized trap door to the shelter. It has a 100-foot oval in ground swimming pool that holds 78,000 gals of water; the pool system is also tied into a large irrigation system. See [here](#) for more.
