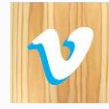
Thanks to **Virginia Faust** for finding a photo of the Tebee Hawkins/Owsley house in Charlotte.

This could be very good or quite bad for one of North Carolina's best examples of mid-century Modernism. The construction permits are done, and the original appliances and original cabinetry were up for sale on Craigslist Raleigh. Will we Love It or Hate It? Stay tuned.
