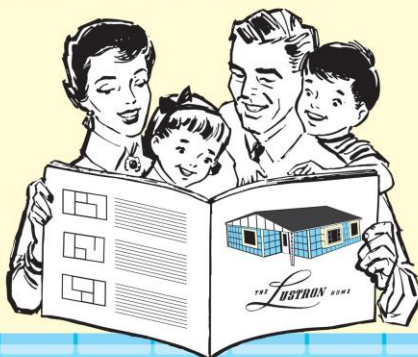

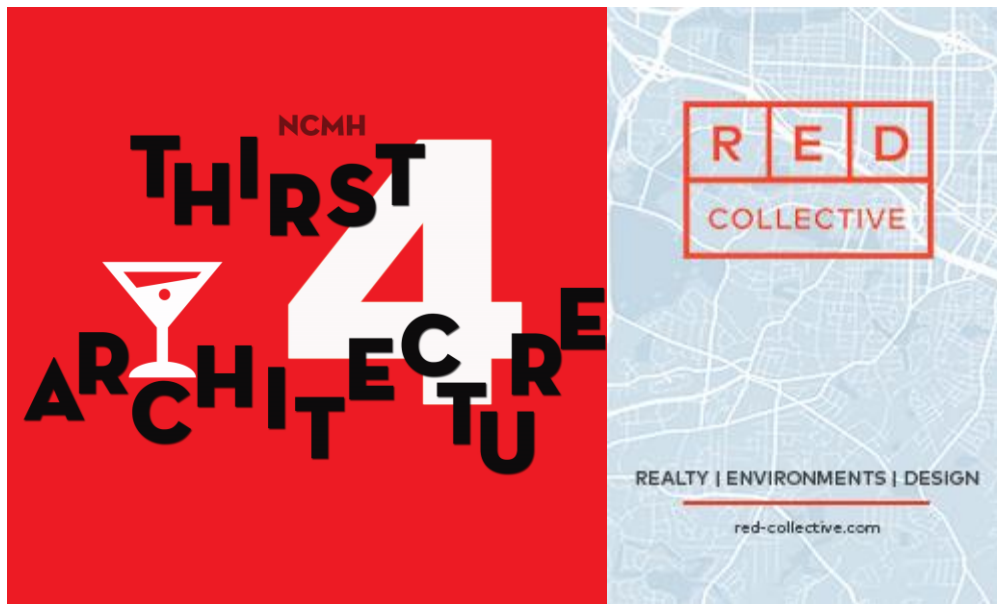

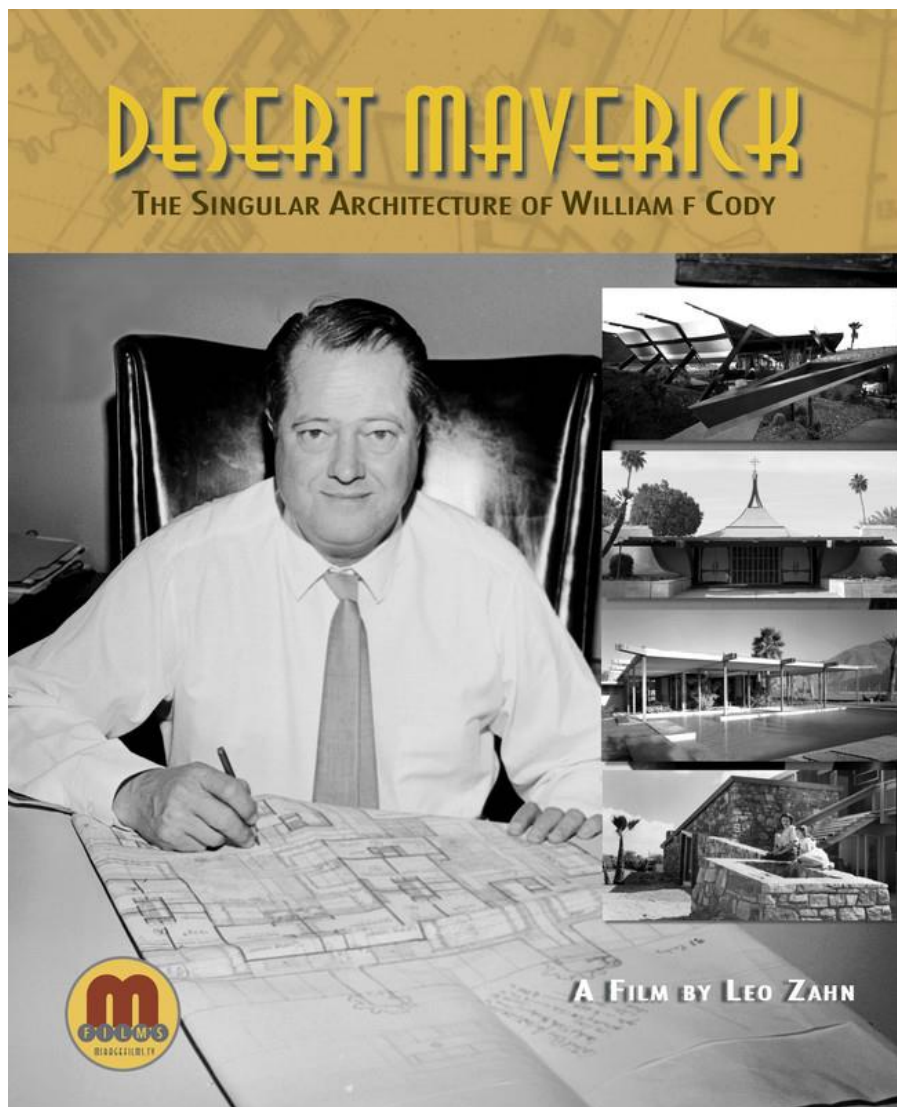

Moho Realty Architecture Movie Series Presents

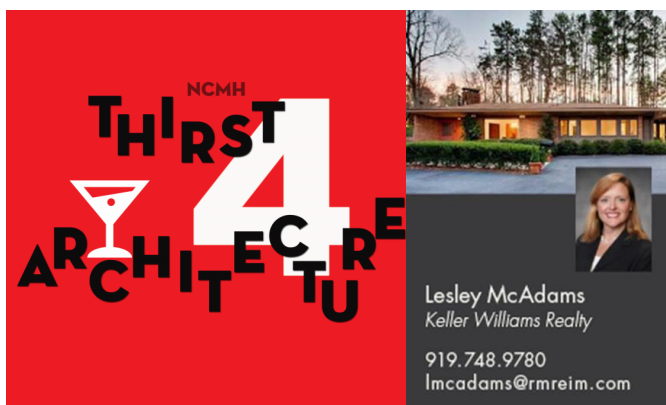
