Structural engineer **Robert Silman** died last week. He was a problem solver; 20 years ago, when a section of Fallingwater was found to be drooping seven inches, he developed innovative ways to fix it. Fallingwater was just one of many <u>Frank Lloyd Wright</u> buildings Silman helped restore. They included Wingspread, the Racine WI residence and New York's Guggenheim Museum, where he used lasers to map the building's surfaces in preparation for a facelift. Though known for its preservation projects, the firm engineered thousands of ground-up buildings, including, in recent years, **Renzo Piano's** Whitney Museum, **Steven Holl's** public library in Queens, **SANAA'**s Grace Farms in Connecticut and **FreeIon Adjaye Bond's** National Museum of African American History and Culture.
