

political, racial, and aesthetic issues behind incarceration.





As reported by **Harold Bubil**, Siebert was known for his elegant manner and eloquence in both the written and spoken word. Among his buildings were the downtown Bay Plaza condominiums, the Siesta Beach Pavilion, the Cooney House on St. Armands Key, the Hiss Studio and Devries-Craig House in Lido Shores, an addition to the Field Club, and a Siesta Key house for novelist John D. MacDonald.


