



We just learned that **Doris Stanley** died last November. She was one of the first female draftsman practicing in North Carolina. Stanley worked two years in newspaper advertising for the Bangor Daily Commercial before coming to Durham in 1950. When the Durham employment office asked about her skills, she mentioned drafting and took a job with <u>William Sprinkle</u>. Together they designed several hundred houses around Durham. "The first day I put paper to pencil, I thought I'd died and gone to heaven," she told interviewers Lynn Richardson and <u>Frank DePasquale</u> in
